

P.R.R. newsletter – Bible summer camps 2019

Fiționești village, Vrancea County, 08–12 July

“Stepping forward ministries” Association invited us to be part again of their wonderful camp (“Living Water”) in the mountains. 63 children (from our PRR residential homes and after school program, and many others from the local community) were served by the great team Steve and Cami lead. Ron Parker from England, who partly covered the travel expenses, was also part of the camp.

“Stepping forward ministries” provided accommodation and meals and everything about the lovely activities our children enjoyed so much – games, competitions, songs, bible lessons, memory verses, excursions in the forest, movies etc.



Bran village, Brașov County, 13–17 August

This was a surprise camp we’ve been offered by our friends in UK, Siloam Christian Ministries, who covered the expenses for food and accommodation.

Vila Negrea was a good host for us, 65 children and 10 adults, providing facilities to run our activities, like craft sessions, games, competitions, songs and bible lessons and memory verses, morning calisthenics, and campfire.

Every day we went to visit tourist spots, Peleș and Bran castles, Râșnov citadel and the Zoo in Brașov.



Bran village, Braşov County, 13–17 August

It was a great experience for most of the children, Bran area being very different historically and culturally from our area. For at least half of the children this was their mountain experience, so their excitement was great during the forest trip and just being surrounded by majestic peaks.



Murfatlar town, Constanţa County, 26 – 30 August

Everyone has been in a situation where you need more of something. But... “More than enough” was the theme of the sports camp we held this summer in partnership with Ambassadors Football, Maranata church and the Town hall in Murfatlar, every day from 9am to 2pm.

About 70 children daily (from our project and the local community) were part of this and learned about the young ruler in the Bible who faced the same problem. They understood the solution Jesus offers is simple – Himself – He is more than enough! Besides football skills, truths to help them put their trust in Jesus alone were presented to the children.

The staff was made by 4 Romanian coaches, the 12 youth from Woodlands church in Bristol, 4 volunteers from OM Romania, interpreters.



The final day was very special – each child got diplomas, medals, footballs, leggings, some small presents 3 photographs to remind them of the whole group and their small teams. The deputy mayor of Murfatlar was also there and had a speech.
