Dear friends,

Two months of this wonderful autumn with lots of sunshine and excellent temperatures have already passed, and we feel it's time to write a little about every area of our work.



VISITORS – All year round people or groups come to visit us. A group of students from Norway visited us, as they do every September, American and Canadian soldiers visited our houses almost weekly to socialize and help with the practical work at Casa Benjamin; they also organized a costumed party. We had Kathleen

from the US encouraging everyone in both homes with her warmth and generous heart. Pastor Adrian and James, our good friends from England, and other friends from the local community visited and spent quality time with our children who were happy to receive their love.



Our residential children were involved in joint activities, for example a three in one party to celebrate Georgiana and Ana and to wish them “Succes in viață!” (“Have a successful life!”) to for Flori, who left Casa Ana to live on her own in Constanța city. Rodica, Ștefan and Cristi were also honored on their birthdays by all the children and staff in the homes and friends in the local community.



All the residential children kept in contact with their natural families. Some of the children developed significant relationships with other important people in their lives, or with families who invited them out or to their homes for short visits.

CASA BENJAMIN – Cristi did very well at college so far and we are very happy to get good reports from his teachers, both concerning his attitude, behavior and his academic work. Romică, a former PRR beneficiary and permanent staff member in Casa Benjamin since 2009 became a father for the third time. His wife, Andreea gave birth to a healthy baby boy this week. With the help of US and Canadian Soldiers from the Black Sea Rotational Forces based in Mihail Kogălniceanu village, practical work advanced significantly. The soldiers pulled down the old fence, removed deep and strong tree roots, prepared the area and poured the foundations for the warehouses. They dug a trench and poured the foundations for the new fence.



AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM – We have moved the program in to a house owned by the Gratton family from England, old and very dear friends of PRR. We will be using their house for the program for a while. (They also generously donated the building in which we run Casa Benjamin, and a mini-bus!) We resumed our meetings on September 13, and the total number of children attending reached 27.
